

Log in to the GlobalProtect portal.


1. Launch a web browser and go to the following URL:

`https://vpn.jncasr.ac.in`

2. On the portal login page, enter your

Name(username) and **Password** and then **Login**.

NOTE:This is not your mail account login

2. Navigate to the agent download page.

2. When prompted again,

Run the GlobalProtect Setup Wizard.

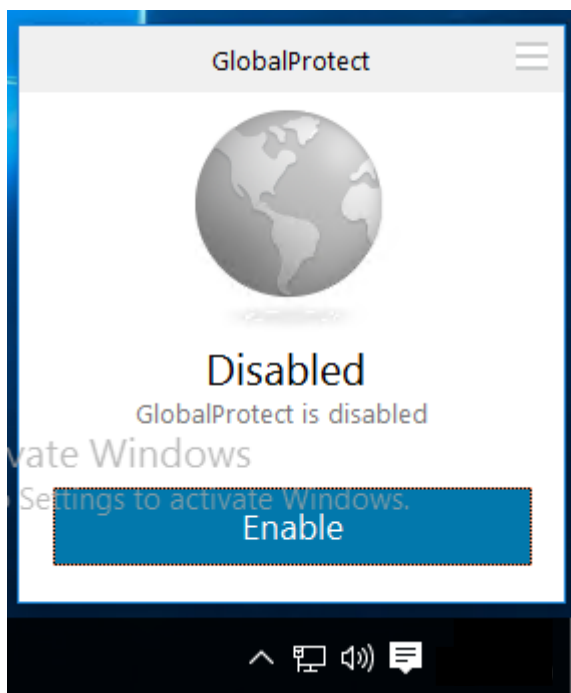
Complete the GlobalProtect agent setup.

1. In the GlobalProtect Setup Wizard, click **Next**.

2. Click **Next** to accept the default installation folder (C:\Program Files\Palo Alto Networks\GlobalProtect) or **Browse** to a new location and then click **Next** twice.

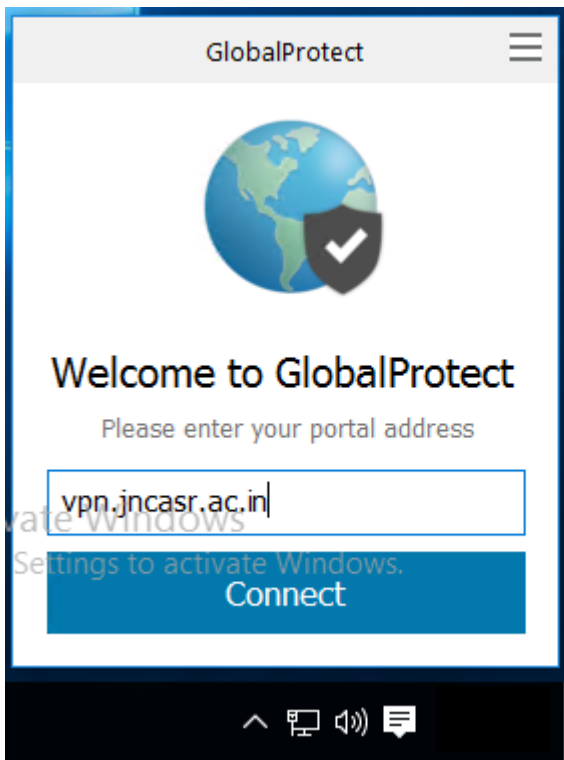
3. After the installation finishes, **Close** the wizard. The GlobalProtect agent starts automatically.

Log in to GlobalProtect.

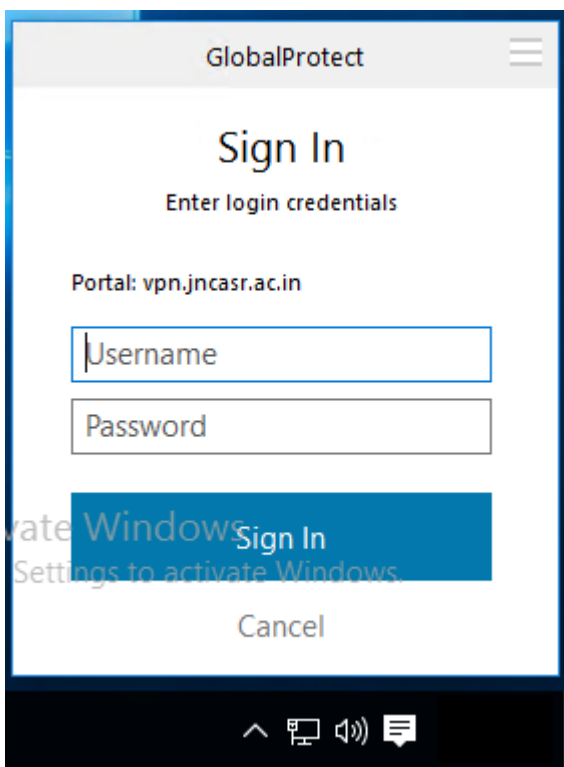


1. Right-click the GlobalProtect system tray icon (🌐) in the system tray and select

Show Panel to log in to GlobalProtect.



2. On the **Home** tab, enter the FQDN or IP address of the **Portal** that your GlobalProtect administrator provided and click **Connect**.



3. If prompted, enter your **Username** and **Password**

If authentication is successful, you are connected to your corporate network. If your administrator set up a GlobalProtect welcome page, it will display after you log in successfully
