Essential Qualifications: Post Graduate Degree in Basic Sciences/Agricultural/Veterinary Sciences OR Graduate/Post Graduate Degree in Engineering/Technology/Medicine from a recognised university.

Prior field experience and excellent observational skills are required, as is physical fitness, as the job demands long hours in the forest. The selected person should be willing to live at the field site, where only basic facilities are available.

Desirable Qualifications:

It is desirable that the applicant be able to drive a four-wheeler (jeep) in field conditions and know (or quickly learn to converse in) Kannada. The ideal applicant will also be familiar with basic statistics and possess good analytical and writing skills.
