If awarded, the Centre will provide necessary administrative and basic R&D infrastructure support for the fellowship duration; the rest of the terms will be as per the fellowship norms. The Centre will be under no obligation to offer regular positions to the Fellows.

The Neuroscience Unit (NSU) is currently seeking applications (<https://www.jncasr.ac.in/research/research-units/neuroscience-unit>). The applicant should have an outstanding scientific record and commitment to excellence in research and teaching. Successful candidates are expected to develop and maintain an active independent research programme, mentor Master- and PhD-level students jointly with permanent faculty and contribute to classroom teaching and outreach activities. Highly motivated candidates who complement the ongoing research programmes of the Unit and/or bring novel technological expertise or interdisciplinary research perspectives will be encouraged. Candidates should have the potential to establish a competitive independent research program and secure research funding for the laboratory.

Eligibility

PhD in relevant areas and at least three years of post-doctoral experience in the field of neuroscience, high-quality publications, and strong academic credentials (please see details below).

Short-listing criteria

Candidates will be short-listed based on seminars and interactions with Unit/Centre faculty members. Short-listed candidates will be provided with a host-institution endorsement/sponsorship certificate. NSU is seeking candidates interested in establishing independent research, preferably in the areas of neurophysiology, cellular, molecular, cognitive, and developmental neuroscience.
