1. Where do I find the link for the application form?

2. When is the last date to apply?

Last date for filling in the Online Application Form is on or before 13th June 2023. However please check our website www.jncasr.ac.in for latest updates.

3. How to apply to JNCASR (JAA & TA) positions

The Candidates must register themselves at <u>https://www.jncasr.ac.in/sites/default/files/Join_Us/Opportunities/2023-05/ADVERTISEMENT.pdf</u>.

On Registration the applicant will be provided with a Login ID and Password. The application process requires the candidate to complete the prescribed online application form and submit it along with relevant documents and prescribed fees. Candidates must apply only through the JNCASR web portal (under Openings), online and **applications received other than the prescribed online application process will be outrightly rejected.**

4. How many times can I register for JNCASR (JAA & TA) exam?

As many times as you wish; but the E-mail ID once used for making a request cannot be used again. Also, the Application fee is non- refundable and hence each Application must be accompanied with a fresh Application fee. There is also the danger of multiple Applications being rejected; therefore, the candidates are advised to be extremely careful while applying.

5. Who can be the Refrees?

Don't use a neighbour, friend or family member as a referee. Referees could include contacts from part-time jobs, temporary work or volunteer positions. You could also supply details of a teacher, lectureror tutor but work references are always preferred.

6. Can I send a black & white photograph with the Application Form?

No, the photograph to be provided in the application form must be identical color photograph. It should not be more than 3 months old. Application with smudged / tampered or hazy photograph will not be accepted.

7. What mode of payment is acceptable for paying the fee?

Candidates can make the application fee payment only online by using the payment gateway provided by using debit card/credit card /Net banking facility/UPI. JNCASR is not responsible for demand drafts sent to JNCASR office and it does not undertake the responsibility to inform the candidates of the same or to return the demand drafts.

4.0 and above) and iOS (version 11 and above). Also clear your browsing history and cache andretry.

11. I realized that I made an error while filling the application form. What do I do?

If you have not clicked on the "Submit" Button, you can edit the application form any number of times. However, the information provided at the time of registration cannot be changed later. If you have already completed your online application form and have submitted the form online, then no changes can be made. You have the option to fill in a new application form with an alternate email id. However please note that fee once paid is non-refundable.

No, you will **not have** the facility to select the session/slot in which you attend exam. The session and test center are allotted through computer assisted randomization process.
