- 3. The honorarium being paid to a Guest Instructor shall be Rs 3000/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs 2,00,000/- per course. One time processing at the end of the course is preferable; partial payments can also be processed. However, advance processing is not admissible.
- 4. No other charges including of conveyance, are admissible in respect of the Guest instructor.
- 5. The class-room teaching can be in-person or by virtual mode, though the former is preferred in the interest of increasing student contact hours.
- 6. The filled-in template to be forwarded to the Academic Office.
- 7. Once approved, Academic Office will send out invitation(s) to the Guest Instructor.
- 8. Nodal Faculty member/Unit office should then arrange/liaison to meet all the requirements of the Guest Instructor (seminar hall booking, arranging Teaching Assistant/TA etc.) till the completion of the Guest assignment.
- 9. If there be requirement of a sitting/office space for the Guest Instructor, Nodal Faculty Member may take it up with the Chair. The space, if available within the Unit, may be allotted for the course duration. If allotted, the Unit Office should inform the Administration for coordination.
